
REPORTING STUDENT PROGRESS

INFORMATION FOR PARENTS



Wetaskiwin Regional Public Schools will report student progress to families four times per year (Quarter System).





- Quarter 1: August 30 November 3rd
- Quarter 2: November 13th January 30th
- Quarter 3: January 31st April 17th
- Quarter 4: April 18th June 26th

Modified School Year Calendar

- Quarter 1: August 30 November 3 rd
- Quarter 2: November 13th January 30th
- Quarter 3: January 31st April 17th
- Quarter 4: April 18th June 13th

REPORTING STUDENT PROGRESS KINDERGARTEN TO GRADE 6

- For Families of Kindergarten Grade 6 Students:
 - Formal Progress Reports will be accessible in January and June.
- Families will be notified via email when Progress Reports are available to be viewed or printed.
- To help families view PowerSchool progress reports, a new 'Report Card Button' will be available this year. Specific instructions will be provided at progress report time.

SPECIFIC INFORMATION FOR REPORTING STUDENTS PROGRESS

In November (Quarter 1) and April (Quarter 3)

- There will be a 'window of time' in which schools invite parents to visit the school for:
 - Celebrations of Learning
 - Student-Led Conferences or
 - Parent/Teacher Conferences
 - Schools will determine and communicate specific dates to parents
- ALL parents will be communicated with regarding their childs' progress, their strengths and suggestions for supporting future growth and improvement.

In January (Quarter 2) and June (Quarter 4)

 In January and June, K-6 families will be notified that formal Progress Reports are available for their viewing/printing in PowerSchool.

REPORTING STUDENT PROGRESS GRADES 7-12

For Families of Students in Grades 7-12:

- Four Progress Reports will be available with comments in PowerSchool in November, January, April and June.
- Families will be notified via email when Progress Reports can be viewed or printed.
- To help families view PowerSchool progress reports, a new 'Report Card Button' will be available this year. Specific instructions will be provided at progress report time.
- Schools will determine and communicate specific dates to parents regarding Parent Teacher Interviews/Student Celebrations of Learning

In November (Quarter 1) and April (Quarter 3)
