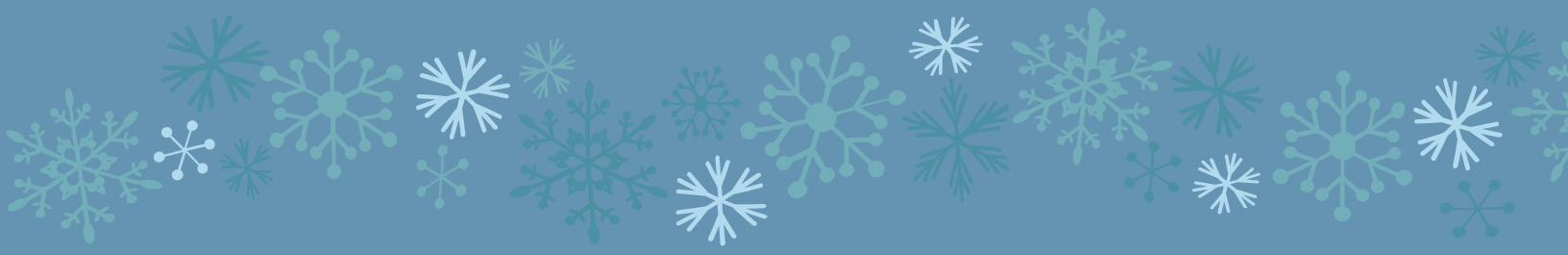

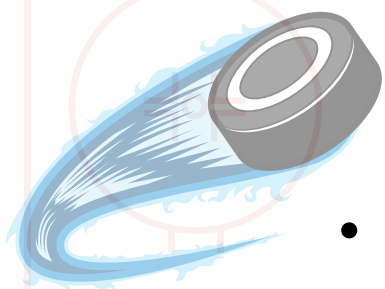
## Grade One/Two - Grekul:

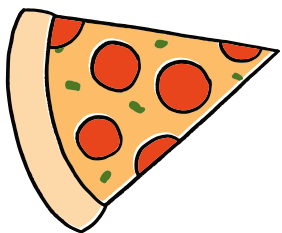

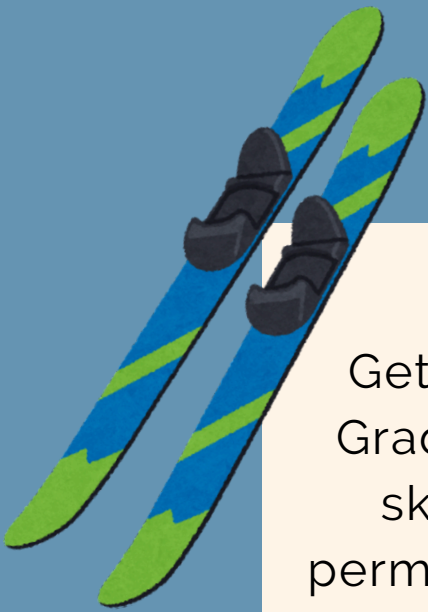


## **BASKETBALL SEASON IS HERE!**
